INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACT

An **INDEPENDENT STUDY** course is one which currently exists in the MCC catalog. It is an individualized educational experience proposed by a student and supported by a faculty member.

A copy of this contract must be submitted to Academic Affairs.

The use of **Independent Study** should be limited as follows:

- 1. The course should be one which is not offered currently and is not scheduled to be offered in the near future.
- 2. The course should be one which the student must complete for graduation before the next time it will be regularly scheduled.
- 3. The student should have, at the time of applying for Independent Study, a grade point average of at least 3.0 (B).
- 4. The student should not be enrolled in more than one Independent Study experience per semester.
- 5. The student and instructor will complete a study plan for approval (on this form) and submit it to the appropriate instructional administrator.
- 6. Upon approval, the instructional administrator will add the requested course to the schedule. The student will enroll in that section through regular registration procedures.
- 7. The Instructor certifies that the outcomes resulting from completion of this contract are equivalent to that of the original course.
